 Performance Management for Immediately Reportable and 24 Hour Reportable Communicable Disease:
 - Immediately reportable diseases are responded to and investigated immediately 100% of the time.
 - 24 hour reportable diseases are responded to and investigated on the same day, or on the next day 100% of the time.
 - *Included in this report are MCRHC towns and Middletown.
 - For the month of December there has been a 36% increase in Total number of reported cases
 - There continues to be a steady increase from November to December with a high number of Influenza cases
