Performance Management for Immediately Reportable and 24 Hour Reportable Communicable Disease:

- Immediately reportable diseases are responded to and investigated immediately 100% of the time.
- 24 hour reportable diseases are responded to and investigated on the same day, or on the next day 100% of the time.
*Included in this report are MCRHC towns and Middletown.
- There has been a 81% increase in Total Number of Reported COVID-19 cases since October 2021
- For the month of November 2021, we have noticed a 75% increase for Confirmed Positive Cases of COVID-19
- There has been a major jump in Influenza cases for the month of November 2021
