Performance Management for Immediately Reportable and 24 Hour Reportable Communicable Disease:

- Immediately reportable diseases are responded to and investigated immediately 100% of the time.
- 24 hour reportable diseases are responded to and investigated on the same day, or on the next day 100% of the time.
 - *Included in this report are MCRHC towns and Middletown.
- There has been a 50% decrease in Total Number of Reported COVID-19 cases since August 2021.
- For the month of September 2021, the percentage of Confirmed positive COVID -19 for the MCRHC jurisdictions (including Middletown) cases is down by 9% since August 2021.
- MCRHC (and Middletown) have seen a slight decrease in the numbers for non-COVID communicable diseases for September 2021.
